



## **Wilson School slates several relief efforts**

The students, staff and families of Wilson Elementary School in Davenport are planning several events to support Hurricane Katrina relief efforts.

The Parent Teacher Association will donate all proceeds from Friday's carnival and ice cream social, set from 6 to 8 p.m. at the school, to the Red Cross. In addition, the staff is coordinating a school-wide yard sale that will take place during the carnival and from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturday. Again, all proceeds will be donated to the Red Cross for hurricane relief.

Students at the school have been busy collecting pocket change and money from piggy banks. (They collected more than \$650 in just one day.) The pocket change collection will take place through Sept. 16 and culminate in a Peacebuilders Skills for Life assembly at 2:30 p.m. that day at the school. The West High School drumline will be on hand for the celebration, and students will present all three checks to the Red Cross at that time.
